I am a Navy Reserve Officer Training Corps (NROTC) Scholarship Coordinator for the Navy Recruiting Division covering all of Southern Indiana. As one of my duties I am writing to request your assistance providing information to your student body about this great opportunity to receive a highly competitive full tuition scholarship, attend one of over 150 leading colleges/universities, and 100% employment after graduation.

Basic eligibility requirements:

- Be at least 17 years old and not older than 23 by June 30th of the year you start college
- Complete high school/equivalent certificate
- Applicants must meet minimum SAT or ACT score criteria

SAT: Math 520 Verbal 530 or ACT: Math 21 English 22

There are two scholarship options: **4yr College** and **Nurse Corps** option. Completing the application does not obligate students in any way. They may dis-enroll from the NROTC program at any time prior to the sophomore year without incurring any service obligation or financial penalty. Completing the NROTC online application and submitting the necessary paperwork are important steps that must be completed in a timely manner.

We are here to answer questions, and to ensure that applications packages are complete and get to the review board on time.

We request you have our information added to any School Counseling Scholarship information /website.

Also, please allow our local Navy Recruiters to setup presentations and attend any College Fairs/Nights to present NROTC information to students.
