## **BOOK—ONE AUTHOR**

Author's Last Name, Author's First Name. <u>Title</u>. Publication Location: Publisher, Year of Publication.

## **Example:**

Forman, James D. Becca's Story. New York: Scribner, 1992.

## **BOOK—EDITOR INSTEAD OF AUTHOR**

Editor's Last Name, Editor's First Name, ed. Title. Publication Location: Publisher, Year of Publication.

## **Example:**

Fadiman, Clifton, ed. The World of the Short Story: A Twentieth Century Collection. Boston: Houghton, 1986.

## **BOOK—TWO-THREE AUTHORS**

1<sup>st</sup> Author's Last Name (give names in same order as on the title page), 1<sup>st</sup> Author's First Name, 2<sup>nd</sup> Author's First Name 2<sup>nd</sup> Author's Last Name and 3<sup>rd</sup> Author's First Name 3<sup>rd</sup> Author's Last Name. <u>Title</u>. Publication Location:
Publisher, Year of Publication.

## **Example:**

Bartlett, Donald L., and James B. Steele. Forevermore: Nuclear Waste in America. New York: Norton, 1985.

## **BOOK—FOUR OR MORE AUTHORS**

Author's Last Name (by alphabetically first), Author's First Name, et al. <u>Title</u>. Publication Location: Publisher, Year of Publication.

## **Example:**

Alexander, Martin C., et al. American Wildlife & Plants: A Guide to Wildlife Food Habits. New York: Dover, 1951.
