WORK IN AN ANTHOLOGY (COLLECTION) OR WORKS

Author's Last Name, Author's First Name. "Title." (of work) Title. (of book) Ed. Editor's First and Last Name.

Location: Publisher, Year of Publication. Page.

Example:

Plath, Sylvia. "Mirror." Harper Anthology of Poetry. Ed. John Frederick Nims. New York: Harper, 1981. 753.

MULTIVOLUME WORK

If there is an author of the work, put the last name and then first name. If there is not an author of the work, then put the title of the work first. "Title of work." <u>Title of Book</u>. Vol. #. Ed. Editor's First and Last Name (if available). Location: Publisher, Year of Publication.
